Also note: If this part has been sold on an "exchange basis" any failure to return the exchange part will void this warranty. 3.5 Mar 15 (LF701)

Any warranty or implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose applicable to this part is limited in time or in kilometers to the duration stated on this warranty form.

The warranty period begins at the date of the sale not the date the part was fitted. We reserve the right under any warranty claim to remedy the situation in any manner at our discretion; we may choose to supply a replacement part or repair the part, or make a partial or total refund depending on the circumstance. We must approve any claim for labour, before the work is started. Any labour will be paid at the rate of \$45.00 per hour net. The warranty claim will never exceed the amount this part has been invoiced for.

What our Warranty Excludes: (Here is a list of what this parts warranty form **does not** cover).

| 1 | Any damage due to non-tradesman like or improper installation , (especially with the transmission torque converter , see 10 below), negligence, alteration, accident or improper use, e.g. damage or failure caused to transmissions by overheating or exceeding the recommended towing or weight capacity . Proper use is stated for all parts in the Ford or Holden vehicle owner's manual or handbook. |
| 2 | The warranty is void if the vehicle odometer has been disconnected or the kilometer or mileage reading has been altered. |
| 3 | Any use related to automotive racing , on or off track or any other type of vehicle competition. Also excluded is any part sold and then later used for racing or competition, including, engine conversions, engines, transmissions, or any other parts or their components. |
| 4 | Any damage caused by lack of proper maintenance as prescribed in the Ford or Holden vehicle owner's manual or handbook. Any failure to carry out vehicle maintenance at the recommended service intervals. Any abuse or thrashing of the vehicle the part is fitted to. |
| 5 | Any damage caused when the following items for transmissions, engine conversions and or engines have not been replaced with new or reconditioned ones. Thermostats, thermostat housings, frost plugs, water pump, radiator & hoses, oil seals, electrical components & cam belt. |
| 6 | Important, we do not cover: oil leaks or oil seal leaks. (It is your responsibility to replace all oil seals when fitting these parts). Incorrect oil, lubricant & fluid levels and types as outlined in the handbook or manual. Any failure to comply with the specified levels and types will void this warranty. You must be able to provide proof that you have followed the vehicle manual or handbook recommendations in regard to these extremely important points. |
| 7 | Damage as a result of overheating, contamination, lack of or incorrect lubricant, inadequate or blocked transmission cooler or lines. |
| 8 | Damage caused by a turbocharger, supercharger or other such part which is not an approved Ford or Holden part or accessory. |
| 9 | Damage to or failure of any ancillary part whatsoever attached to the engine and supplied free of charge with the engine, such as alternators, distributors, turbos, injection pumps, injectors, glow plugs, thermostat housings and the like. Parts supplied free of charge are never covered by any warranty. |
| 10 | Very Important for transmissions: Damage caused by incorrect installation of the torque converter. |
| 11 | Any consequential damage or costs; loss of time, inconvenience, loss of use of the vehicle, towage, or any other economical loss. |
| 12 | Any vehicles that are operated at any time outside of New Zealand . |
| 13 | Any part installed under an existing Ford or Holden new vehicle warranty . |

Transmission Check Guide: **It is very important** that you or your qualified installer perform the following checks at installation time, after initial running, again the next day and then at subsequent regular intervals thereafter:

1. Check and follow the manual or handbook for the correct transmission fluid level and type.
2. Check that the transmission cooler and lines have been correctly flushed and cleaned before installation.
3. Check that the transmission torque converter has been installed correctly.
4. Check all plugs, sensors and wiring that are connected to this transmission.

Engine Check Guide: **It is very important** that you or your qualified installer perform these under hood checks at installation and at subsequent recommended regular intervals:

1. Check and follow the manual or handbook for the correct engine oil level and type.
2. Check all engine coolant levels and add if necessary.
3. Check all belts and hoses for wear and tear and replace as necessary.
4. Check the radiator, all the plugs, wiring and sensors that are connected to this engine.

It is your responsibility to complete, sign and send a copy of this warranty form to Advanced for Ford & Holden.
